

Calf Club Art and Craft Week

(Week 1 Term 4 – 15th to 18th October)

All children of Otakiri School will all be involved in spring art and craft activities in the first week of next Term. These will be displayed, in the hall, on our Agricultural Day, Thursday 18th, October. Some art/craft items will be made at school on Wednesday 17th, October, some will be made in the days leading up to Thursday and other activities will be made at home over the school holidays. **See below.**

Children must choose at least 2 activities. They may choose more if they wish. Judging will be done in age groups.

Junior 5-7yrs

Intermediate 8-10yrs

Senior-11 yrs +

Lego, miniature gardens, sand saucers and floral arrangements are to be done **at school**. This year we are using a small pudding bowl filled with sand so that the flower stems will stand more securely. **(Plastic pudding bowls will be supplied if you need them)** Lego is brought at your own risk. Children must supply their own soil and tray for miniature gardens, flowers etc. If you have an abundance of flowers that your child can share with classmates it would be much appreciated.

Senior students (11+) may only use natural materials in their miniature gardens. They can make fences, huts etc from ice-block sticks at home. A jar lid can be used as a pond.
