

All students have the opportunity to apply for a role in our Student Leadership team. I hope that you can encourage your child to have a go and take on new challenges.

This term we will have a strong focus on our LEAD values and having a growth mindset. We will spend time encouraging students to take on new challenges and step up as a leader of our school.
